Before the court is the parties' joint request that the court adopt the recommendations of Special Masters Gonzalez and Peace that Claimants 200002006 and 200000551 are eligible as Nonhire Claimants for priority hiring and monetary relief.¹ (Aug. 13, 2013, U.S. Ltr. (Dkt. 1185.)
